There are also 11 premium rooms measuring 25 square meters and three accessible rooms for guests with mobility issues. Each room is furnished with highend beds and a spacious bathroom with a shower or bathtub. A workspace with a Nespresso coffee machine and a large flat screen television with Chromecast are also included.





Clients enjoy a full breakfast with an all-you-can-eat buffet which includes a variety of fresh and local hot and cold dishes, including gluten-free products and grain toppings. With its cozy atmosphere and elegant décor, the **30-seat bar-lounge** is open to enjoy a drink with friends or colleagues. It boasts an exceptional coffee machine, the Marzucco KB90, along with a selection of snacks.

To better welcome clients, this pet-friendly hotel also features a patio and a seminar space composed of two meeting rooms which accommodate 20 and 40 people respectively. A 37-space parking lot is available and charging stations for electric cars will soon be installed.
