



The newly renovated Kyriad Prestige Saint-Malo reopens its doors!

The Kyriad Prestige Saint-Malo hotel announces its reopening this month after a year and a half of renovations. New rooms, a wellness area, local charm, and unique design... No detail was overlooked in the renovation of this Saint-Malo establishment.

As part of this renovation, the Kyriad Prestige Saint-Malo, owned by David Prenveille, who also owns the Kyriad Saint-Malo Ouest Dinard, called upon no fewer than twenty local companies, including the architects from Bailleul & Plessis and the STINDEL firm.

Guests at the hotel will now enjoy living spaces that combine high-end comfort with local charm, featuring a 130-seat room, a continental breakfast buffet served every morning, and an evening snack menu. A bar located at the heart of the hotel is also open daily until 10:30 PM. Thanks to partnerships with local producers, travelers will have the chance to discover regional products such as honey, jams, yogurts, regional pastries, and the famous Saint-Malo 'craquelins'.





The Kyriad Prestige Saint-Malo has also introduced a brand-new relaxation area featuring a heated indoor pool measuring 6m by 19m, accessible to both adults and children aged 3 and up, with a jacuzzi area. For a complete wellness experience, guests can enjoy a sauna and a hammam, accommodating up to 4 and 8 people respectively, along with a fitness room equipped with a stationary bike, treadmill, and elliptical machine.





In addition to the renovation of the common areas, the existing 71 double, triple, or family rooms are complemented by the construction of 29 new rooms (four of which are accessible to people with reduced mobility). They offer all the comfort and elegance characteristic of the brand, featuring high-quality bedding, a workspace, air conditioning, and a bathroom. Fully equipped, they are well-suited for both business and leisure guests.

The hotel's geographical location at the tip of Brittany, close to the major roads leading to Rennes and Normandy, and not far from the Saint-Malo train station, allows for easy access to water activities, walks along the Customs Path, as well as the Grand Aquarium and the beaches of Saint-Malo. Additionally, the hotel offers a free and secure private parking lot with 100 spaces, as well as a secure bike parking area.
